

DOG PARK RULES

**USE OF THIS DOG PARK IS AT YOUR OWN RISK!
HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS & BEHAVIOR
OF THEIR DOGS AT ALL TIMES.**

**THERE WILL BE SOMEONE AT THE ENTRANCE CHECKING FOR
RABIES TAGS AND LICENSES.**

- All dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the park.
- All dogs must have current rabies and all other vaccinations as required by The City of Montgomery Health Department and should be healthy and free of contagious diseases and parasites.
- Dogs must wear current license tags in the park.
- Never leave your dog unattended: dogs must be in view of and within voice control of their handler at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damages or injury to other dogs or persons caused by their dog.
- Handlers must carry a leash with them at all times when in the dog park.
- Handlers are responsible for picking up and disposing of their dogs waste.
- Children under 9 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
- Dogs in heat are prohibited.
- The Dog Park is for humans and dogs only – no other animals are permitted.
- Dogs showing any signs of aggression must be immediately leashed and removed from the dog park by their handlers.
- All dogs must be under the control of an adult 18 or over.
- There is a limit of 2 dogs with any handler in the dog park at one time.
- Handlers must stop their dogs from digging and are responsible for filling in holes made by their dog.
- Small bite-sized training treats are permitted, but no other food or drink (dog or human) is allowed in the dog park.
- No smoking in the dog park.
- No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades or motorized vehicles are permitted.
- Violators will be subject to removal from the park and suspension of dog park privileges.
